▶ **INSS suspends pension payments to around five hundred beneficiaries**

27/02/2024 - The National Social Security Institute (INSS) suspended pension payments to around five hundred pensioners in the province of Sofala last year due to a lack of proof of life. [Read more \(page 18\)](#).

▶ **More than 18,000 INAS beneficiaries in Manica have not received their benefits for 14 months**
