Searching for a resource in the Library – a quick introduction

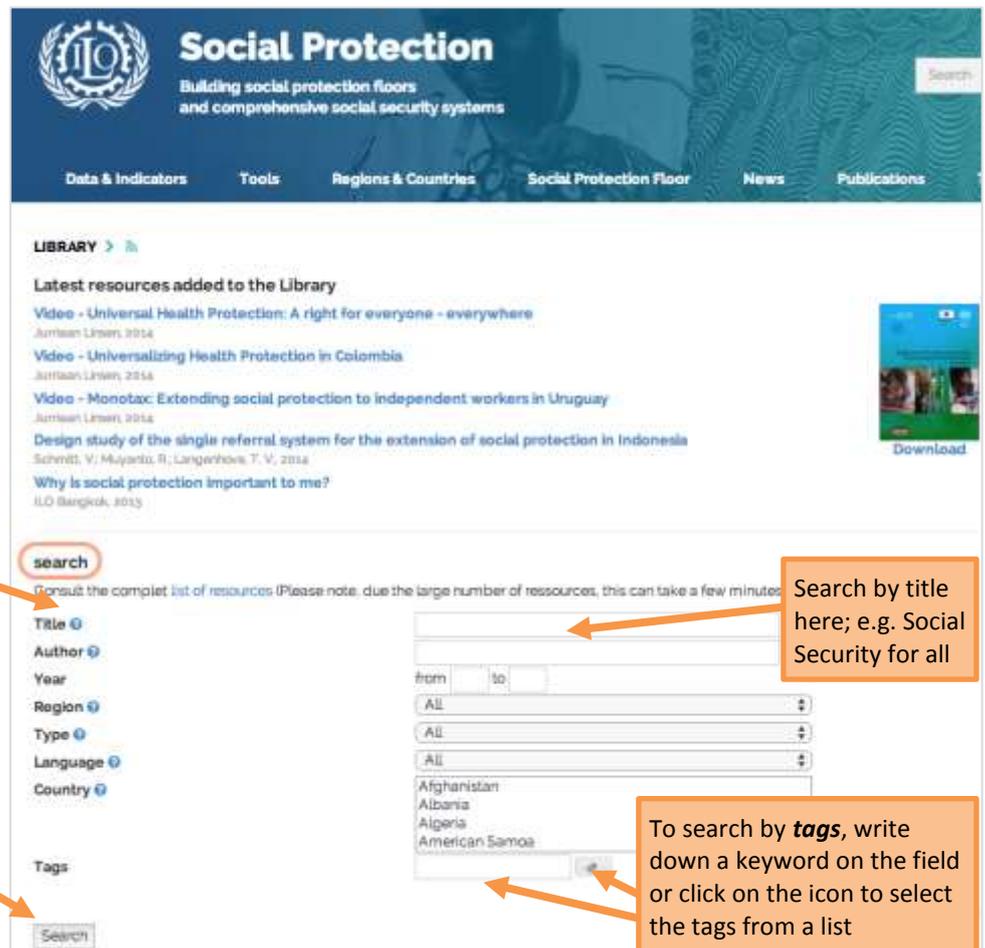
STEP 1

Click on **Library** in the **Publications** menu on the top of SPP homepage (www.social-protection.org).



STEP 2

On the **Library** page, scroll down to **Search** for a resource. You can search by title, author, year, region, type, language, type, country and tags.



Place your mouse over the blue information icons for help on how to fill in what to select in the search fields

Click **Search** to see your search results

Search by title here; e.g. Social Security for all

To search by **tags**, write down a keyword on the field or click on the icon to select the tags from a list
