

Mr Virgilio Levaggi is currently the Director of the ILO Department of Partnerships and Field Support (PARDEV). He has worked for the International Labour Organization (ILO) since 1994, in different positions - both at headquarters in Geneva and in the field. These roles include: serving as the Deputy Regional Director for Latin America and the Caribbean and Director of the ILO sub-regional office for Central America, Mexico and Panama.

Previously, Mr Levaggi was the Chief of Cabinet of the Prime Minister and Minister of Labour of Peru (between 1991 and 1992) and advisor to the President of the Peruvian employers' organization CONFIEP from 1992 to 1994. In 1994, Mr Levaggi was appointed as a Special Advisor to the UN Secretary-General for the Social World Summit. He has served as a professor at two Peruvian universities and has published several books on world of work and entrepreneurial issues and a range of articles which have been featured in several newspapers.
