Valerie Schmitt is the Chief of Social Policy, Governance and Standards Branch, Social Protection Department, ILO Geneva. She is also leading ILO's Flagship programme on building social protection floors for all.

Born in 1972, Ms. Schmitt holds a Master of Advanced Studies (first year of doctoral studies programme) in quantitative economics from Paris Sciences Economiques (Laboratoire du Delta) and a Master of Business Administration with honours from HEC (Europe's highest ranked MBA programme by the Financial Times). She also holds a bachelor's degree in Philosophy from the University of Paris IV – La Sorbonne.
