



Results achieved in 16 countries: strategies adopted in 7 countries, legal frameworks adopted in 9 countries, operations improved in 10 countries





With the ILO's Social Protection Results Monitoring Tool you can find out more about ILO's past, ongoing and planned projects and the results achieved in the area of social protection




Based on our current records, ILO's Flagship programme has contributed to expanding social protection for 12 million people.

Extension of social protection to workers in the informal economy



Double objective:

- Better protecting informal workers through adapted contributory and tax-financed schemes, aiming at universal coverage
- Facilitating transitions from the informal to the formal economy through an integrated approach




Resource mobilization

In October 2018, **68% of the 2016-2020 budget has been secured**. We need your support to achieve results and impact in all countries.




