Oscar Cetrángolo is an economist graduated from the University of Buenos Aires and M Phil in Development Studies from the University of Sussex (Institute of Development Studies).

He is a researcher at the Buenos Aires Interdisciplinary Institute for Economic Studies (IIEP BAIRES), from the University of Buenos Aires and University of Tres de Febrero; Professor of Public Finance at the same University.

Between 2012 and 2015 he was the Director of the Master's Degree in Economics at the University of Buenos Aires and between 2001 and 2011, he worked at ECLAC (UN) as an expert in Public Policies. Previously, he filled different positions in the public sector (Central Bank, Planning Secretariat, Budget Secretariat and Fiscal Incomes Secretariat) and, between 1999 and 2001, he was appointed Undersecretary at the Ministry of Economy. Also, he worked as a consultant for different international organizations (ILO, OPS, IADB, UNDP) and published several works on public policies, mainly health, taxation, fiscal federalism and education.
