Chargé d'affaires a.i.

Claude Jentgen, born on 10 April 1973, was appointed chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Embassy of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg in Laos in January 2016, while assuming at the same time the duties of head of the development cooperation office for Laos, Myanmar and Vietnam.

Previously, he was posted in Hanoi from 2013 to 2015 as chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Embassy of Luxembourg in Vietnam. He served as head of the Asia desk of the Department for Development Cooperation in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from 2008-2013. Before that he was from 2004 to 2008 chargé d'affaires a.i. at the Embassy of Luxembourg in Cabo Verde. From 2001 to 2004, Claude Jentgen worked as an associate expert with the United Nations Drug Control Programme (UNDCP) and later with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) in Laos. He joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the year 2000.

Claude Jentgen holds a Master of International Business Law from the University of Paris Panthéon-Sorbonne and a Master 2 in International Relations of the University of Clermont-Ferrand.

Claude Jentgen is married to Ms. Chanhom Boutdakham and they are the parents of two young sons.
